

# The Eriksbergshallen sound and noise policy

Eriksbergshallen hosts a variety of events that involve persons and groups who view sound levels very differently. As the management of the Eriksbergshallen, we have a responsibility to ensure that the various organizers at Eriksbergshallen comply with our policy.

Organizers must present us with, and secure our consent for, all rehearsals, sound checks and performances in advance of the event. In addition, the organizer must take into account the maximum allowable sound levels set forth below, and not exceed them..

It is important to avoid opening doors during periods of "sound." This applies also to the garage doors. There should be a "gate" function at the entrance. Also remember that more than one event may be taking place at Eriksbergshallen at the same times, including conferences and other arrangements..

**The objective is not to disturb permanent residents, hotel guests or other events taking place at the same time in Eriksbergshallen. In addition, our visitors should not be exposed to excessive noise levels, or risk resulting injuries.**

If you are a lessee or user of Eriksbergshallen or are responsible for sound, bands or other similar matter, please remember that you are obliged to keep within the limits set forth below. We have installed sound monitors on the premises. If you are shown to exceed these levels, you must immediately adjust your sound level, or else, stop playing.

## Outside of Eriksbergshallen

Activities must be conducted in such a way so as to avoid discomfort to our neighbours through noise or other disturbances. The following levels may not be exceeded:

Outdoors at night **after 10:00 p.m.** near homes: Equivalent continuous sound level of 40 dBA, maximum sound level of 55 dBA.

Indoors in homes in the vicinity: Equivalent continuous sound level of 25 dBA, maximum sound level of 35 dBA.

## Inside Eriksbergshallen

The organiser shall ensure that the music will be kept at such a level so that no guests will be exposed to a higher sound level than 115 dBA max and 100 dBA equivalent for continuous noise. The purpose of these requirements is to prevent hearing-related injuries.

**After 10 p.m.**, we apply stricter requirements in order to avoid disturbances in our vicinity. The values listed below have been arrived at through measurements with the help of WSP Akustik in December 2003. The measurements were done in Eriksbergshallen and simultaneously in a flat in the vicinity.

Eriksbergshallen South:	Average sound level 90 dBA
Eriksbergshallen Central:	Average sound level 90 dBA
Eriksbergshallen North:	Average sound level 95 dBA
